5. General description or background of proposed request.

In partnership with Denver Climate Action, Sustainability and Resiliency (CASR), Denver Economic Development & Opportunity's Workforce Development Division has been awarded a State Opportunity Now grant in the amount of \$1,538,593.00 to increase the education and training capacity for electric vehicle maintenance technicians in the Metro Denver region.

Dollars will be distributed to 5 educational institutions including Denver Public Schools – Montbello Career and Technical High School, Jefferson Public Schools – Warren Technical High, Red Rocks Community College, Pickens Technical College and Ohm on the Range. These organizations will implement these funds to allow them to enhance and expand automotive training classes' focus on electric vehicles.

The 5 organizations receiving funds are part of the Zero Emission Vehicles in Colorado Partnership (ZEVCP) who, as a group, identified the desire to pursue these funds with DEDO being the eligible backbone organization. Other Metro Denver educational organizations providing automotive training were invited to join this group when it first began and have been involved over the past 24 months.

Funds will be distributed to 5 educational institutions including Denver Public Schools – Montbello Career and Technical High School, Jefferson Public Schools – Warren Technical High, Red Rocks Community College, Pickens Technical College, and Ohm on the Range allowing them to enhance and expand automotive training classes' focus on electric vehicles. Over the next 2 school years, 900 students will participate in these education and training programs. For high school students, the grant will focus on providing pathways to post-secondary education and for those already in post-secondary education, the grant will focus on connecting graduates to quality jobs in the electric vehicle maintenance sector.
