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Executive Summary

Grant Acceptance:

HOME Investments Partnerships (HOME) Program

- See Ordinance Request for chartfield detail (Fund/Org/CFDA, etc.)
- Grant objectives – to provide decent and affordable housing to lower income households; expand the capacity of nonprofit housing providers; strengthen the ability of state and local governments to provide housing and; leverage private sector participation.¹
- Matching requirements – 25% of funds drawn for project costs. The City fulfills its match requirement through other non-federal housing programs, such as the Housing Incentive Program (IHO) and through Private Activity Bonds.

Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG)

- See Ordinance Request for chartfield detail (Fund/Org/CFDA, etc.)
- Grant objectives – to provide annual allocations to States, larger cities, and counties for a broad range of activities that preserve and develop viable urban communities.²
- Matching requirements – None.

Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA)

- Grant objectives – to provide and assist in all forms of housing designed to prevent homelessness, including appropriate supportive services and resource identification, for persons confirmed with *Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome* (AIDS) or related diseases, including infection with *Human Immunodeficiency Virus* (HIV).³
