COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE:

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

A BILL

For an ordinance amending Division 5, Article VI of Chapter 49 of the Revised Municipal Code, delaying the effective date of the Sidewalk Program and Sidewalk Fund.

WHEREAS, voters approved the "Denver Deserves Better Sidewalks" initiated ordinance in November 2022;

WHEREAS, Denver Charter § 8.3.1(F) grants City Council the power to amend or repeal an initiated ordinance six months after passage;

WHEREAS, the ordinance does not require the manager of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure to bill and collect the sidewalk service charge by a specified date and the manager has not started such billing or collection;

WHEREAS, the intent of this ordinance is to clarify that the manager may not collect the sidewalk service charge or otherwise implement the ordinance prior to July 1, 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That a new section 49-156, D.R.M.C., shall be added to read as follows:

Sec. 49-156. Effective Date.

This division 5 shall be effective July 1, 2024.
