## Contract Details

● DENVER

- Contract Bid Amount - \$29,351,362
- Contractor - Interstate Highway Construction
- Scope of Work
  - Remove and replace distressed concrete panels on the runway, taxiways F and G and connecting taxiways
  - Widen the asphalt runway shoulders
  - Widen Taxiway F safety area
  - Replace the runway and taxiway centerline lighting system
- Construct new high speed Taxiway F8





## Scope of Work for RW 16L/34R Project

- Remove and replace all pavement striping
- Widen and pave an existing vehicle service road to facilitate snow removal and overall maintenance of the complex (from Taxiway F7 to F10)
- Construct an emergency aircraft parking area with new service road on Taxiway WC near Firehouse 4

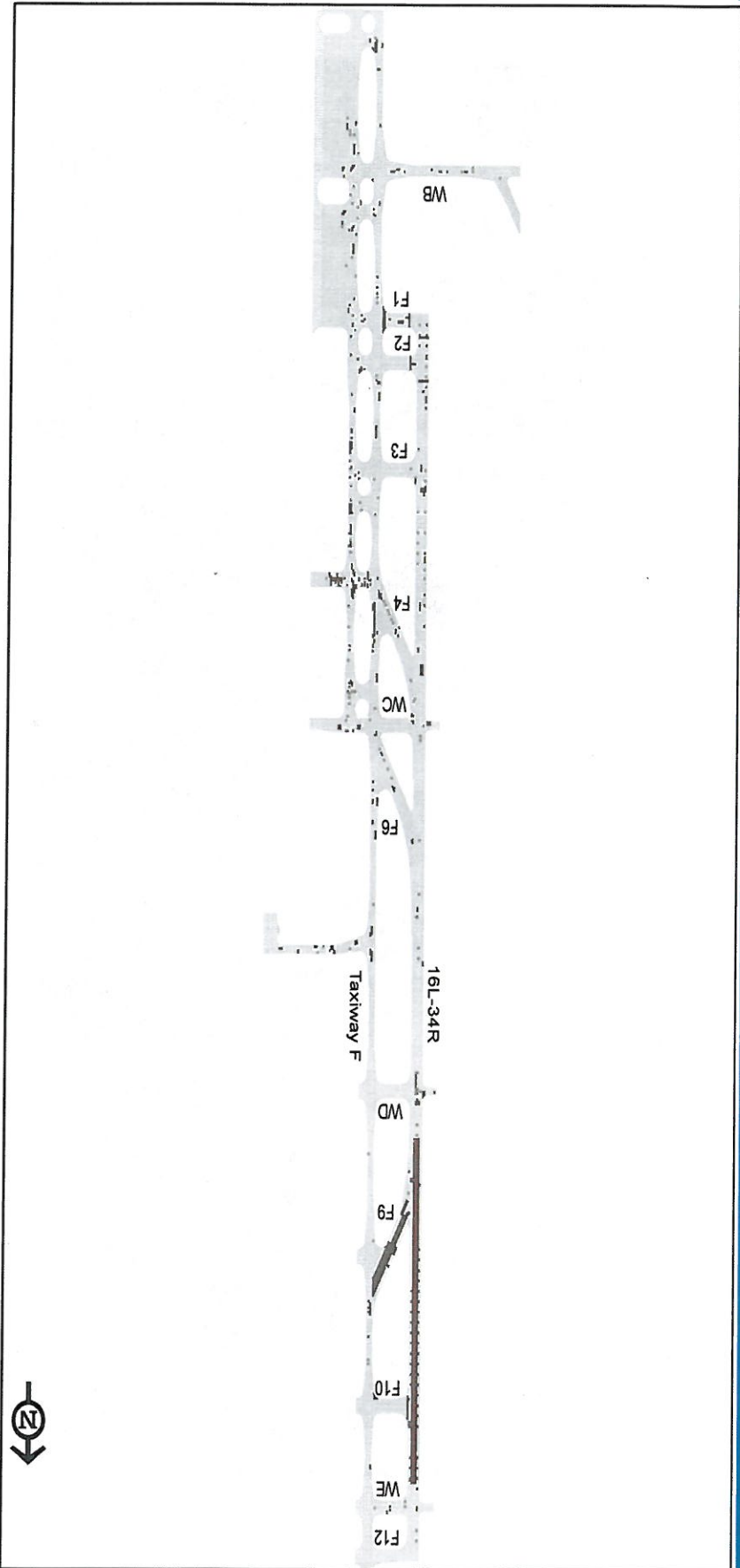
