Basic need services include but are not limited to: general delivery mail services, secure personal belongings storage, telephone access, clothing bank, shower facilities. Limited supportive services are targeted to the most vulnerable guests, such as client support, transportation assistance, life skill development, substance misuse referral and education, and referrals to benefit enrollment and medical treatment.
