6. **General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

- Contract would allow the continued operation of an Automated Photo Red Light System, as part of an overall traffic management strategy, to enhance safety on City streets, promote traffic calming, improve neighborhood quality of life, and improve and maintain current levels of traffic mobility.
- The proposed sixth amendment would allow the extension of the agreement for six (6) months through 06/30/2015; and, appropriate an additional \$81,000 bringing the total agreement amount to \$1,104,272.00.
 - A six-month extension would ensure continuity of the program while a formal Request for Proposal (RFP) process is taking place. A multi-disciplinary team is working on the development of the RFP; including City Purchasing, Denver Police Traffic Operations, Denver County Court, City Technology Services, City Treasury, and City Traffic Engineering.
 - Monthly cost and all other terms and conditions would remain constant during this six-month extension.
