- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
  - a. Scope of Work

General Services is seeking approval of a contract with Xcel Energy for the provisioning of steam, to be used for heating, at the new Justice Center. General Services has negotiated a steam rate below the current retail rate. The rate is guaranteed to remain 4% below retail steam rates for the remainder of the agreement. The initial term expires 12-31-2034.

Steam will be used to heat the new Justice Center facility. Steam will be provided through Xcel Energy's district steam system, which serves only customers in the downtown area. By taking advantage of the available steam service, the City is able to avoid the capital cost of installing boilers at the Justice Center. The City will also realize on-going operating savings by avoiding maintenance costs for boilers.

The City currently uses Xcel's district steam at the City and County Building, Webb Building, Denver Art Museum, Central Library, Police Administration Building, Denver Performing Arts Complex, and the Colorado Convention Center.
