A BILL

**For an ordinance to approve annual programs of the Department of Public Works and waive the need for further City Council approval for specific contracts let pursuant to the annual program.**

**WHEREAS**, under Charter §3.2.6, the City Council has the authority to approve contracts of \$500,000 or more; and

**WHEREAS**, under Charter §3.2.6(H), the City Council has the authority to waive the requirement that such contracts be submitted to the council for approval or disapproval under Charter §3.2.6, and

**WHEREAS**, City Council has reviewed the annual program for the Department of Public Works which consists of:
