Attach executive summary if more space needed: (who, what, why) The City and County of Denver Department of Aviation (Aviation) is undergoing a 10-year program to characterize, and when needed, restore environmental media that have potentially been impacted by historic pollutant releases. The program will include at a minimum, implementation of the PFAS Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCUP) for DEN overseen by the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment (CDPHE), and the investigation and remediation of closed oil and gas production sites at DEN overseen by the Colorado Energy and Carbon Management Commission (ECMC). This contract will perform environmental characterization work at DEN, and will extend for a term of 5 years, with a value of \$5,250,000. This project supports DEN's Vision 100 Sustainability guiding principle. PFAS is one of the most significant environmental risks facing airports, both because of the unique usage patterns and the extraordinary public pressure associated with reducing PFAS contamination. Participation in CDPHE's PFAS Grant Program will further DEN's efforts to address PFAS contamination and strengthen ties between DEN and CDPHE.
