That upon consideration of a change in the zoning classification of the land area hereinafter described, Council finds: 16 17 a. The land area hereinafter described is presently classified as D-C, UO-1. 18 b. It is proposed that the land area hereinafter described be changed to D-TD, UO-1. 19 Section 2. That the zoning classification of the land area in the City and County of Denver 20 described as follows shall be and hereby is changed from D-C, UO-1 to D-TD, UO-1: 21 22 Lots 29 through 32, inclusive, Block 131, 23 **EAST DENVER** 24 City and County of Denver, 25 State of Colorado. 26 27 in addition thereto, those portions of all abutting public rights-of-way, but only to the centerline 28 thereof, which are immediately adjacent to the aforesaid specifically described area. 29 Section 3. That this ordinance shall be recorded by the Manager of Community Planning and 30 Development in the real property records of the Denver County Clerk and Recorder.
