A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America Department of Housing and Urban Development concerning the “Community Development Block Grant FY18” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America Department of Housing and Urban Development, for the “Community Development Block Grant FY18” program, which is identified as Grant Number B-18-MC-08-0005, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 201844783-00, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the United States of America to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreements shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 16000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Director of Economic Development, is as follows:

The foregoing authorization will fund the city’s housing, business, and neighborhood development activities that preserve and develop viable urban communities. Expenditures of said funds are authorized for the period from January 1, 2018 to September 1, 2025.
