A BILL

For an ordinance correcting Ordinance No. 118, Series of 2016 and further amending section 42-53 concerning the salary of the Chief of Police

WHEREAS, § 9.6.4 of the Charter provides that the salary of the Chief of Police shall be as set forth in ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the salary of the Chief of Police is codified in Sec. 42-53 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code along with the salaries of Deputy Chiefs, Division Chiefs, and Commanders; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 765, Series of 2014, the salaries of the Chief of Police, Deputy Chiefs, Divisions Chiefs and Commanders were set for the period 2015-2017, with the salaries escalating each year by a percentage equal to the annual salary increases for police officers as reflected in the police collective bargaining contract; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 118, Series of 2016, Sec. 42-53 was amended to reflect an annual salary of \$199,000 for the Chief of Police in 2016, but the ordinance inadvertently failed to include conforming amendments to the section addressing the Chief's 2017 salary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That section subsections (c) and (d) of section 42-53, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

Sec. 42-53. - Same—Police chief, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders.

c) Effective January 1, 2017, the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:

Police chief ~~\$187,494~~ \$202,980

1 Deputy chief \$174,410
2 Division chief \$166,111
3 Commander \$151,002

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5 (d) Effective July 1, 2017, the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and
6 commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:
