a. Scope of Work

Grant acceptance between City and County of Denver and Colorado Department of Transportation to disburse Federal Enhancement funds to replace two substandard trail ramp structures with a single, multi-directional ramp at least 10-feet wide and ADA-compliant at Confluence Park. A new pedestrian plaza and stairway, and upgraded lighting will also be constructed.

This ordinance establishes capital grant fund numbers and appropriates \$2,765,000 to be received from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) towards the proposed design and construction of trail ramps at Confluence Park, a new pedestrian plaza and stairway, and other trail improvements as necessary.
