Business, Workforce & Sustainability

BR11- Adds \$250,000 to and extends by one year the contract with Parsons 0777 Brinckerhoff (for a total of \$650,000) to assist DIA in capital project planning.

Government & Finance

BR11- Establishes a capital grant fund and appropriate budget to accompany 0775 the IGA between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation (CDOT) for the construction of a bicycle and pedestrian crossing at the Union Pacific Railroad Tracks at 47th Avenue and York Street, as approved by City Council in June 2010.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

RR11- Approves the Mayoral appointment of Lance Benninghoff to the Denver 0770 Women's Commission for a term effective immediately and expiring on June 30, 2013 or until a successor is duly appointed.

RR11- Approves the Mayoral appointments of Benita Muñiz and Nadia Ahmad 0771 to the Human Rights & Community Relations Advisory Council for terms effective immediately and expiring on April 1, 2013 or until a successor is duly appointed

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

BR11- Vacates the entire alley bounded by Walnut, Larimer and 24th streets 0773 and Park Avenue West for the Arapahoe Square development project in Council District 9.

BR11- Approves a \$588,253.50 contract with Colorado Boring Company for 0776 traffic signal system improvements at 52 intersections.

BR11- Approves transfer of \$2,135,105 from Wastewater Management's Storm 0727 Capital Improvement fund to General Fund CIP account, specifically the Justice Center Grant fund, following transfer of assets to Wastewater Management for storm drainage purposes, namely a constructed wetland pilot project to demonstrate the benefit of a regional approach to storm water quality requirements under the City's MS4 permit.

RR11- Grants a revocable permit to Zeppelin Development to encroach in the 0772 alley right-of-way with underground parking connecting two buildings; 10 foot diameter pipe for a stormwater detention system; and 4 foot diameter sanitary sewer manholes at 225 S. Harrison and 250 S. Jackson.

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the St. Luke's Pedestrian Mall 0780 Local Maintenance District, located in Council District 8

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the Delgany Street Pedestrian 0781 Mall Local Maintenance District, located in Council District 9.

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the Broadway Pedestrian Mall A 0782 Local Maintenance District, located in Council Districts 7 and 9

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the Broadway Pedestrian Mall B 0783 Local Maintenance District, located in Council District 7.

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the Phase II Broadway Pedestrian 0784 Mall Local Maintenance District, located in Council District 7.

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the Broadway Viaduct Pedestrian 0785 Mall Local Maintenance District, located in Council Districts 8 and 9.

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the Consolidated Morrison Road 0787 Pedestrian Mall Local Maintenance District, located in Council District 3.

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the South Broadway Streetscape 0788 (Wesley Avenue to Yale Avenue) Local Maintenance District, located in Council District 7.

BR11- Approves the 2012 annual budget for the Tennyson Streetscape 0789 (Portions of West 38th Avenue to West 44th Avenue) Local Maintenance District, located in Council District 1.
