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10 **For an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the General Government Special**  
11 **Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from the Colorado Division of**  
12 **Homeland Security and Emergency Management to fund the City and County of**  
13 **Denver for the “2020 Emergency Management Performance Grant” program.**

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15 **WHEREAS**, the Colorado Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management has  
16 awarded Emergency Management Performance funds to the City and County of Denver for the  
17 past 19 years; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Colorado Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management has  
19 sent a letter of intent (LOI) to the Office of Emergency Management stating their intent to provide  
20 funds for 2020; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said letter of intent,  
22 a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 20200023;

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
24 **DENVER:**

25 **Section 1.** Expenditures are hereby authorized from the General Government Special  
26 Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11000, the amount of money in the following tabulation to be  
27 expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
