CONTRACT DESCRIPTION

- This contract is a Design-Build Contract for the comprehensive design and construction services for a new DIA Data Center.
- Benefits include:
 - Relief of existing DIA data centers which are reaching service capacity limits
 - Green Initiative (Target LEED Silver)
 - Cost Savings (Reduce O&M costs and costly upgrade to existing data centers
 - Improvement to internal and external customer services by DIA Technologies
- The Selected Firm is PCL Construction Services, Inc.

SELECTION PROCESS

- This Contract was competitively selected by Request for Proposal
- 9 proposals were received
- Selection Committee Panel Members
 - DIA Airport Infrastructure Management Division
 - DIA Technologies Division
 - Denver Community Data Center Experts
- Technical Advisory Panel Members
 - 1 Architectural (DIA Airport Infrastructure Management)
 - 1 Mechanical (DIA Airport Infrastructure Management)
 - 1 Electrical (DIA Airport Infrastructure Management)
 - 2 Data Center experts (DIA Technologies)



SELECTION PROCESS

Criteria:

- Design / Build Team that meets the project budget, schedule and project program criteria
- Best technical solution that meets the project program criteria and facility performance requirements
- Total project costs to deliver the proposed data center facility
- Schedule to deliver the proposed data center facility
- PCL is located in Denver, CO and employs 3,500 plus full-time salaried staff and over 6,500 hourly trades workers



GOALS

- DENVER
- The M/WBE goal for the project is 2%
 - The facility will be prefabricated in Indianapolis, Indiana and shipped to the site for final assembling therefore M/WBE goal was established for site construction only
- Subcontractors:

 - Merrick & Company
 - McKinstry
 - Ground Engineering Consultants
- M/WBE goal will be achieved by PCL's Compliance Plan which has been approved by DSBO

CONTRACT TERMS AND AMOUNT

- Term:
 - 20 Months from Notice to Proceed
- Amount:
 - Lump sum of \$10.0M

- We are requesting City Council approve this design / build contract for the new DIA Data Center
 - Offers DIA a concurrently maintainable Data Center and provides undisrupted services to the Airport and its customers
 - Provides relief to the existing DIA data centers which are reaching service capacity limits
 - Provides an efficient data center facility that reduces operational costs
 - Potentially will provide co-location services for other City and County of Denver agencies that are in need of data center space, specifically for Continuity of Operations / Disaster Recovery purposes
