PURPOSE:	Appointment for Denver American Indian Commission

Function:

The Denver American Indian (DAIC) is tasked with advising the Agency for Human Rights & Community Partnerships Executive Director and the Mayor on issues and concerns that impact and are of importance to the American Indian community.

Appointment Process:

The Mayor appoints up to 21 members and City Council confirms appointment for 3 year terms, with a 3 term limit.

Term: 7/1/2025-6/30/2028 or until a successor is duly appointed.
