- BR13-0029 Approves a three-year, \$15,000,000 on-call construction contract with FCI Constructors, Inc. at Denver International Airport (DIA) (201208782).
- BR13-0023 Approves a no-cost extension of the contract with John Rohrer Construction Co. for one year (to a total of 3 years) for terminal roadway moisture protection and repairs at Denver International Airport (DIA) (PLANE-201102006).
- BR13-0027 Approves a \$1,050,000, three-year, on-call environmental services contract with Brown and Caldwell Inc. for environmental services on an as-needed basis for Denver International Airport and the former Stapleton Airport (201208638).

- RR13-0039 Approves a \$5,000,000, five-year master purchase order with World Wide Technologies for products and services related to Network Infrastructure Support Services primarily for Denver International Airport (0643A0213).

- BR13-0031 Amends the contract with Integral Recoveries, Inc., to extend the term through February 2014 to provide services for Denver County Court

related to collecting delinquent fines and fees (201204950).

- BR13-0032 Amends the contract with Senter Goldfarb & Rice to increase the contract amount by \$350,000 for a total contract cost of \$1,150,000 to provide legal services (CE13018).
- BR13-0033 Amends the contract with Ingram Library Services, Inc., to extend the agreement through December 31, 2013 and to add \$5,945,000 for book purchases and cataloging services for the Denver Public Library (201103203-02).
- BR13-0037 Approves an eleventh amendment to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department contract to add three years through December 31, 2015 for a total contract amount of \$579,213 for law enforcement services in the Denver mountain parks system (POLIC CE-31245-11).
- RR13-0021 Approves the Mayoral reappointments of Ferooza Eswaran, Peggy Lore, Pam Sweetser, Jinny Kim, Lynn Sargent, Chuong Le, Erin Yoshimura, and the appointment of Sylvia Smith-Brown to the Denver Asian Pacific-American Commission for terms effective immediately and expiring on January 22, 2015 or until a successor is duly appointed.

- BR13-0042 Amends the contract with HNTB Corporation for the Colorado Center Bicycle/Pedestrian Bridge over I-25 to extend the term from July 1, 2013, to December 31, 2015, and add \$321,968, for a new maximum of \$1,831,600, for additional professional design services (CE92032-02).
- BR13-0043 Revokes Ordinance No. 743, Series of 2005, which granted a revocable permit to the U.S. Government to encroach into the public right-of-way with various items at the Bryan Rogers Courthouse and Federal Building
