A BILL

For an ordinance to make appropriations from the Capital Improvement Fund.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department seeks to build a new transfer station at the Cherry Creek site to accommodate the City’s growing compost program; and

WHEREAS, additional funding is required in the Capital Improvement Fund to support the design of this new transfer station;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Capital Improvement Fund, Accounting No. 31000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
