**A BILL**

**For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the Special Trust Fund Series for the “Unclaimed Minimum Wages” program.**

**WHEREAS**, companion ordinance CB19-1237 establishes minimum wage requirements in the City and County of Denver; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to said ordinance, the Mayor wishes to establish a Special Trust Fund to temporarily hold certain payments of unclaimed wages made by Denver employers to meet minimum wage requirements for their workers;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the Special Trust Fund Series, Accounting No. 56000, an “Unclaimed Minimum Wages” Special Trust Fund, Accounting No. 56260, for the purpose of accounting for certain payments of unclaimed wages made by Denver employers to meet minimum wage requirements for their workers.

**Section 2.** Unclaimed wages received from Denver employers for Accounting No. 56260 shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Trust Fund No. 56000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Unclaimed Minimum Wages” Special Trust Fund, Accounting No. 56260, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this ordinance to be expended by the Auditor. Allowable expenditures include reimbursements to workers for certain unclaimed wages as well as transfers to the General Fund of amounts that remain unclaimed after a three-year period. This fund is revenue-based and non-lapsing.

1       **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be  
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
