Health, Safety, Education & Services

- BR12-0900 Amends the Warren Village contract to add \$177,500, for a total contract amount of \$532,500, for a term through December 31, 2013, to provide housing to 32 individuals and supportive services to homeless women and single parent families through the Warren Village First Step Program (SOCSV-CE11117-02).
- BR12-0901 Amends the Denver Health & Hospital Authority contract to add \$225,000, for a total contract amount of \$900,000, to provide transitional residential treatment and case management services to 25 chronically homeless individuals through the Comprehensive Housing and Residential Treatment Services (CHaRTS) program at Denver Cares (SOCSV-CE01069-03).
- BR12-0902 Amends the Mental Health Center of Denver contract to add \$850,292, for a total contract amount of \$3,374,412.38, to provide housing and treatment services to 75 chronically homeless individuals (SOCSV-CE01060-03).

- RR12-0906 Grants a revocable permit to 16M, LLC, to encroach into the public right-of-way with an underground parking garage along Market Street between 16th and 15th streets in Council District 9.
- RR12-0907 Approves the final subdivision plat of Belcara Filing No. 2 for residential development at 401 S. Garfield St. near Cherry Creek South Drive in Council District 6.
- RR12-0908 Grants a revocable permit to Simpson Housing, LLC, to encroach into the public right-of-way with steps and planter walls in front of 2749 Walnut St. in Council District 9.
- RR12- Grants a revocable permit to Legacy Partners, Inc., to encroach into the

0910 public right-of-way with steps, railing and walls at 2131 Lawrence St. in Council District 9.

BR12- Approves a \$2,481,788.05 contract with BT Construction to construct
0909 4,000 feet of storm sewer from Iowa and Broadway to Asbury and Logan in Council District 7 (201207767).
