7 **For an ordinance amending Section 2-3 of Chapter 2 of the Denver Revised  
8 Municipal Code regarding electronic signatures.**

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

10 **Section 1.** That Section 2-3 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code shall be amended by  
11 deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined as follows:

12 **Sec. 2-3. - Electronic signatures.**

- 13 (a) *Definitions.* For the purposes of this section, the words and terms used shall be defined  
14 as set forth in the Colorado ~~Government~~ Uniform Electronic Transactions Act, currently  
15 contained in Title 24, article 71.43 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, as the same may be  
16 amended from time to time. The definitions of words and terms set forth in the remainder  
17 of this chapter shall also apply herein to the extent that they are not inconsistent  
18 therewith.
- 19 (b) *Authorization.* Whenever any provision of the charter, this Revised Municipal Code or any  
20 ordinance, rule, regulation, executive order, or policy of the City and County of Denver  
21 expresses a requirement for a signature of any person or the city seal to be affixed or  
22 associated with any form or document, that requirement shall be deemed to be fully  
23 satisfied by an electronic signature or seal when supplied in the manner specified by the  
24 city.
