7 **For an ordinance establishing a "Safety Private Donations Fund" program in**
8 **the Safety Special Revenue Fund and the means for authorizing expenditures**
9 **from such fund.**

11 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

12 **Section 1.** There is hereby established in the Safety Special Revenue Fund, Accounting
13 No. 12000, a "Safety Private Donations Fund" Program, Accounting No. 12711, for the purpose
14 of funding programs, equipment and materials throughout the Safety Department.

15 **Section 2.** Monies received from contributions, donations, project incomes or other source
16 of private receipts shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund
17 No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of
18 the City and County of Denver.

19 **Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Safety Private Donations Fund"
20 Program, Accounting No. 12711, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in
21 Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Manager of Safety.

22 **Section 4.** The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
23 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
24 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
