Persons average 18 months in treatment before becoming stable. Clients receiving ACT services show a marked reduction in new arrests as well as reduction in detox, emergency and hospital stays. Services to be delivered include day to-day treatment with the emphasis on treatment plan compliance, coordination with the Court to Community team and cases receiving court oversight.
