9. General description or background. Attach executive summary if more space needed: Denver Arts & Venues received \$20M in Vibrant Bond funding toward a \$120M renovation of Boettcher Concert Hall. This is the first time Boettcher Concert Hall will be undergoing major renovation for since its opening in 1978. Of the \$120M, Colorado Symphony has committed to raising a minimum of \$15M through the ability to sell naming rights of the building.

CSA will have the rights to utilize naming rights as a tool to fundraise a minimum \$15M for the renovation of Boettcher Concert Hall. They will provide Denver Arts & Venues a fundraising plan and seek approval for any donation/name prior to commitment. CSA will follow specific guidelines on what areas can be sold and types of donors that are allowable.
