Business Development

BR16- Amends the 2016 Budget for the Colfax Business Improvement District
0134 located in Council Districts 9 and 10.

Finance & Services

RR16- Adds \$425,000 to the purchase order with Transwest for a new total of
0123 \$900,000 for medium-heavy equipment and trailer parts for City
vehicles (0667A0413).

BR16- Grants the authority to acquire all or any portion of any property
0137 interest in up to 24 properties as part of the Mississippi and Federal
Retail Center Alley Improvement Project in Council District 3.

Infrastructure & Culture

BR16- Vacates a portion of the alley bounded by Utica Street, West 43rd
0127 Avenue, Tennyson Street, and West 41st Avenue within the Chavez
Park boundaries in Council District 1.

RR16- Approves a \$661,065 contract with Rush Peterbilt Truck Center for three
0132 refuse trucks.

BR16- Relinquishes two utility easements bounded by South Colorado
0135 Boulevard, East Kentucky Avenue, South Birch Street, and East
Mississippi Avenue in Council District 6.

RR16- Adds one year and \$300,000 to the contract with Standard Parking
0136 Corporation for new maximums of five years and \$898,792 for
additional parking management services at 2004 Chestnut Place
(201206764).

Governance & Charter Review

BR16- Amends the Classification and Pay Plan by adding Events Facilitator at
0128 pay grade 613-C.

RR16- Approves the Mayoral appointment of Angelina Sierra-Sandoval to the
0126 Denver Latino Commission for a term effective immediately and expiring
1-1-18, or until a successor is duly appointed.

Safety & Well-being

RR16- Amends a loan agreement with Del Norte Neighborhood Development
0138 Corporation on an 80-unit affordable housing rental project known as
Avondale Apartments located in Council District 3 to update repayment
terms for the loan, extend the covenant by ten years, and allow for the
condominiumization of the collateral.

Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
