24-1266 A resolution authorizing and approving the expenditure and payment from the appropriation account designated "liability claims," the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00) made payable to Falgien Warr & Iyer, PC COLTAF, in full payment and satisfaction of all claims related to the civil action captioned *Antonio Estrada-Barda and Alejandro Estrada v. Melvin Fubler and The City and County of Denver*, which was filed in the District Court for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, Case No. 2024CV30297.
