A BILL

**For an ordinance renaming Lincoln Park located at 1325 West 11th Avenue as
“La Alma/Lincoln Park”**

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver acquired the Lincoln Park property located at
1325 West 11th Avenue in 1885 and it is a designated park under the Denver Charter; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the procedure established by the Department of Parks and
Recreation’s Naming Policy, residents of the La Alma/Lincoln Park neighborhood submitted a
petition to re-name Lincoln Park as “La Alma/Lincoln Park” offering as the basis for the proposed
re-naming: “The name La Alma/Lincoln Park, which is already commonly used by residents to refer
to Lincoln Park, would continue to honor the rich history and culture of the La Alma/Lincoln
Neighborhood that surrounds the park. The name La Alma celebrates the diversity of the citizens
who live in the neighborhood. The park will be a continuing tribute to the neighborhood and its
residents”; and

WHEREAS, the Manager of the Department of Parks and Recreation supports the proposed
re-naming of this park and the Denver Parks and Recreation Advisory Board voted at its meeting
on July 11, 2013, to recommend the re-naming of Lincoln Park to “La Alma/Lincoln Park”.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That Lincoln Park be and the same is hereby renamed, and shall be known as,
LA ALMA/LINCOLN PARK.

Section 2. That this action shall be effective upon the final adoption of the ordinance.
