1st Judicial District (Jefferson County, Pop. 565,783) - \$208,000 - planning to ask for 1.5 or 2% increase for each year of his term beginning 2017, up to \$220,000 at the end of his term.

8th Judicial district (Larimer County, Pop. 315,988) - \$196,911 - is seeking a 10% increase for four year period
