4 **A RESOLUTION**

5 **Laying out, opening and establishing as part of the City street system a parcel**
6 **of land as North Federal Boulevard, located near the intersection of North**
7 **Federal Boulevard and West 2nd Avenue.**

8 **WHEREAS**, the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure of
9 the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and
10 necessity require the laying out, opening and establishing as a public street designated as part of
11 the system of thoroughfares of the municipality that portion of real property hereinafter more
12 particularly described, and, subject to approval by resolution has laid out, opened and established
13 the same as a public street;

14 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

15 **Section 1.** That the action of the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation
16 and Infrastructure in laying out, opening and establishing as part of the system of thoroughfares of
17 the municipality the following described portion of real property situate, lying and being in the City
18 and County of Denver, State of Colorado, to wit:

19 FAST STATIC GPS SURVEY. THE LINE BETWEEN POINT MOE AND POINT ALAMEDA BEARS
20 S.24°42'20.3"W. THESE TWO STATIONS ARE NGS STANDARD HORIZONTAL CONTROL
21 DISKS SET IN CONCRETE WITH STAMPINGS "MOE 1994" AND "ALAMEDA 1977"
22 RESPECTIVELY

24 declared laid out, opened and established as North Federal Boulevard.

25 **Section 2.** That the real property described in Section 1 hereof shall henceforth be known
26 as North Federal Boulevard.
