That there is hereby levied for the year 2013 on and against all taxable property, real, personal, and mixed, within the following special districts a tax as indicated upon every dollar of assessed valuation to be collected at the time and in the form and manner and with like interest and penalties as other taxes are collected, to be paid monthly to the treasurers of said districts:
