

## Councilmember CdeBaca Amendment to the Mayor's Proposed 2021 Budget **20-1255**

## Councilmember CdeBaca

Madame President: I move that the Mayor's Proposed 2021 Budget be amended in the following particulars:

- 1. On page 596, in the line titled "Chief of Police," (which resides in Control 3511000 in Appropriation 3510000) reduce the amount in the 2021 Recommended column by \$1,000,000 from \$4,968,431 to \$3,968,431.
- 2. On page 600, in the titled "Police Patrol Districts," (which is Control 3513000 in Appropriation 3510000) reduce the amount in the 2021 Recommended column by \$1,000,000 from \$121,064,685 to \$120,064,685.
- 3. On page 247, in the line titled "Marijuana Policy," (in Appropriation 4001000) increase the amount in the 2021 Recommended column by \$2,000,000 from \$615,469 to \$2,615,469 to increase funding for marijuana social equity collective development.
- 4. Make other appropriate adjustments to comments, tables, schedules, and figures in the Mayor's Proposed 2020 Budget as may be required to reflect the actions in this amendment.

**Explanation:** Marijuana was deemed an essential business preventing disruption of their business model. We have had less than 5 person of color owners in the state of Colorado. We need to not only allow a social equity license but facilitate the incubation of person of color owned licensees as we open licensure opportunities. This could be a match amount that could be utilized to facilitate trainings, applications, etc.
