16	(a) After issuance of a medical marijuana dispensary license, the licensee shall mal	ke no			
17	physical change, alteration, or modification of the licensed premises which materially or				
18	substantially alters the licensed premises or the usage of the licensed premises from the				
19	plans and specifications submitted at the time of obtaining the original license without the				
20	prior written consent of the Director. For purposes of this section, physical changes,				
21	alterations, or modifications requiring prior written consent shall include, but not be li	mited			
22	to:				
23	(1) Any increase in the total size or capacity of the licensed premises.				
24 25	(2) The sealing off, creation of or relocation of a common entryway, doorv	/ay or
