A bill for an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the General Government Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from the Colorado Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management to award funding for the “2017 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG)” program.

WHEREAS, the Colorado Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management awards EMPG grant funds to the City and County of Denver annually; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management has sent a letter stating their intent to provide EMPG FY17 grant funds to the Denver Office of Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said letter of intent to fund, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 17-0062;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the General Government Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

The foregoing authorization is for the full amount indicated in a prior Award Letter as referenced in the Letter of Intent (LOI) to Fund from the Colorado Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management for the EMPG FY17 program.
