

Proclamation No. 12-0514

In recognition of Brothers Redevelopment Paint-A-Thon Day in the City and County of Denver, July 21, 2012

Introduced by Councilmember López

WHEREAS, through a partnership with Denver Employees Volunteer Opportunities (DEVO) and Brothers Redevelopment, 100 plus Denver City employees will volunteer their time to paint homes of deserving senior homeowners for the agency's 34th Paint-A-Thon; and

WHEREAS, all painting will be completed free of charge for homeowners—saving the city's fixed-income seniors thousands of dollars in home maintenance costs: and

WHEREAS, volunteers will be beautifying homes and preserving home values in Denverarea neighborhoods as a result of their participation; and

WHEREAS, the Paint-A-Thon is a great way to show that City employees not only work in Denver but also care about Denver's citizens and communities; and

WHEREAS, the Paint-A-Thon truly makes a difference in the lives of Denver citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER THAT:

Section 1. The Council recognizes the day of July 21, 2012, as Brothers Redevelopment Paint-a-Thon Day in the City and County of Denver.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation and that a copy be transmitted to the DEVO board.
