A RESOLUTION

To set a public hearing before City Council on August 4, 2025 for the formation and establishment of the Broadway Denver General Improvement District and approval of the 2025 and 2026 Work Plan and Budget for the Broadway Denver General Improvement District.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, ex officio Clerk, of the City and County of Denver (“Clerk”) seeking the formation and establishment of the proposed Broadway Denver General Improvement District in accordance with a proposed creation ordinance (“Petition”); and

WHEREAS, a proposed 2025 and 2026 Work Plan and Budget for the proposed Broadway Denver General Improvement District has been filed with the Clerk (“Work Plan and Budget”); and

WHEREAS, a public hearing will be held by City Council prior to City Council’s consideration of the Petition and proposed creation ordinance and the Work Plan and Budget for the proposed Broadway Denver General Improvement District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The Denver City Council hereby sets the hearing for 5:30 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, on August 4, 2025 at 1437 Bannock Street, Room 451, Denver, Colorado, on considering the approval of the Petition in accordance with a proposed creation ordinance and the Work Plan and Budget for the proposed Broadway Denver General Improvement District.
