10 11	WHEREAS, Part 6, Article 25, Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorizes		
12	the creation of improvement districts in municipalities;		
13	WHEREAS, Part 6, Article 25, Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorizes		
14	improvement districts to fix, and from time to time increase or decrease rates, tolls, or		
15	charges for any revenue-producing services or facilities furnished by the improvement		
16	district and to pledge such revenue for the payment of indebtedness of the improvement		
17	district;		
18	WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes the Treasurer of the City and County of		
19	Denver to collect and enforce rates, tolls, and charges on behalf of an improvement district.

21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY

23	Section 1. That Article XII, Chapter 20 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code shall

29	Sec. 20-301. Definitions.		
30	As used in this article, the terms "rates, tolls, or charges" shall have the meanings		
31	given to them in Part 6, Article 25, Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes.		
32	Sec. 20-301. Fixing of Rates, Tolls, or Charges.		
33	Part 6, Article 25, Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorizes improvement		
34	districts to fix, and from time to time increase or decrease rates, tolls, or charges for any		
35	revenue-producing services or facilities furnished by the improvement district and to		

1	pledge such revenue for the payment of indebtedness of the improvement district.			
2	Sec. 20-303. Collection and Enforcement of Rate	s, Tolls, or Charges.		
3	(a) Part 6, Article 25, Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes establishes a process			
4	for improvement districts to collect and enforce the rates, tolls, or charges fixed by the			
5	improvement districts.			
6	(b) There is hereby created an additional process for the collection and enforcement of			
7	rates, tolls, or charges fixed by improvement districts created pursuant to Part 6, Article 25,			
8	Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes. The process in this section is in addition to, and			
9	in lieu of, the process established in Part 6, Article 25, Title 31 of the Colorado Revised			
10	Statutes. Upon request of an improvement district, the Treasurer of the City and County of			
11	Denver is authorized to collect and enforce the rates, tolls, or charges fixed by the			
12	improvement district in the following manner:			
13	(1) the rates, tolls, or charges shall be billed at the same time and in the same			
14	form and manner as ad valorem taxes;			
15	(2) the rates, tolls, or charges shall be paid in full in a single payment on or			
16	before the last day of February; and			
17	(3) if the rates, tolls, or charges are not pa	d in full on or before the last day of		
18	February, they shall be delinquent, and shall be enforced at the same time and in the			
19	same form and manner as ad valorem taxes.
