A BILL

For an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 699, Series of 2014, the annual appropriating ordinance, to increase the Denver Preschool Program appropriation based on funds that will be generated from the passing of the November 4, 2014, 2A ballot measure.

WHEREAS, the appropriations originally set forth in Ordinance 699, Series of 2014 are being changed to reflect the increased revenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 699 Series of 2014, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 1. General Fund Appropriations for Agencies: There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund (Accounting No. 01010) for the year 2015 the amounts of money indicated in the following tabulation to be expended for the purpose indicated by the title of each item. The appropriations are to be expended upon the order of the respective officers, or employees designated, or of their duly authorized agents.”
