This amendment adds project Tranche 4 to the 25-year Master Operator Agreement with McKinstry Essention, LLC, for the design, development, installation, operation, and maintenance of community solar photovoltaic generating facilities and electric vehicle chargers owned by the City as part of the Renewable Denver Community Solar Initiative.

Project Tranche 4 is for four (4) solar carports with co-located EV charging at DPS high schools totaling 1,000 kWac of solar capacity. The project adds Manual HS (district 9), North HS (district 1), JFK HS (district 2), and Thomas Jefferson HS (district 4) to the Renewable Denver Community Solar portfolio and the City’s collaborative partnership with Denver Public Schools. 100% of the bill credits generated from this array will be donated to lower the utility bills of approximately 200 low-income DPS families in need spanning all city council districts. Additionally, the team will provide community engagement and workforce benefits including, but not limited to Installation Basics Training; a target of at least 10% of the solar workforce hired from underserved communities in Denver; presentation of the Solar Futures curriculum to DPS students; and STEM Mentoring and Internship offerings for DPS students.

CASR continues to submit applications to Xcel Energy to approve additional solar projects across the city for Denver’s solar portfolio. The above project represents projects thirteen to sixteen in the Renewable Denver Community Solar Initiative.
