Purpose: This is a contract to operate and maintain staff for the Community Reentry Project (CRP) to reduce recidivism and improve the quality of life and safety in the Denver community.

Scope of services with performance bench marks: CRP staff, in conjunction with Denver County Jail staff, will assess client risks and needs and provide core services (pre-approved, offender specific cognitive-behavioral skills curricula, employment readiness, coaching, and placement, benefit and ID acquisition, and case planning and management) to clients in jail and transitioning from the Denver County Jail to the community. Persons who are fully engaged in core services may be eligible for limited emergency transitional housing, public transportation and related vouchers (i.e. clothing). Depending on budget and availability, services and/or referrals may also include educational supports (i.e. GED preparation), family reunification and parenting, healthy living skills, relapse prevention, mental health, trauma and substance abuse treatment referrals, computer skills and related resources and supportive services.

Cost/value: \$549,025.02

Source of funds: Crime Prevention and Control Commission Special Revenue Fund

Benefit: The Community Reentry Project provides critical services CRP provides services to not less than 200 new and continuing clients per month for inmates and recently released persons from the county jail. The program is designed to target medium to high risk to reoffend inmates upon entrance into jail and provide services to them through transition into the community, with the goal of reducing recidivism.
