6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

The contractor provides bus transportation to homeless persons on a daily basis from the Denver Rescue Mission (1130 Park Avenue West, Denver, CO 80205) to various approved recreation center/shelter locations throughout the Denver metro area. This funding is being added to cover expected costs for transporting homeless to the Peoria location. It was previously not known when or if the service would continue to Peoria.
