6 **For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Culture**
7 **and Recreation Special Revenue Fund Series to make a cash transfer to Parks**
8 **Legacy Capital Improvement Funds.**

10 **WHEREAS**, in 2018, Denver voters approved Ballot Measure 2A, which increased the sales
11 tax rate by 0.25 percentage points starting January 1, 2019, to be spent on various programs and
12 projects that support Parks, Trails and Open Space: and

13 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 0806, series of 2024 approves a Purchase and Sale Agreement
14 between the City and County of Denver, Jefferson County and The Trust for Public Land for the
15 Tibaldo Property, 167-acre property located between Denver Mountain Parks' Mount Pence Tract
16 and Bergen Peak properties off State Highway 103 in Evergreen: and

17 **WHEREAS**, the City desires to transfer cash from the Parks Legacy Special Revenue Fund
18 to the Parks Legacy Improvement Projects Fund to be utilized for the acquisition of the Tibaldo
19 Property;

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21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**

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24 **Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the Culture and Recreation Special
25 Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15000, listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby
26 RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount
