6 **A BILL**

8 **For an ordinance establishing a new Fund in the General Government Special**  
9 **Revenue Fund Series for the “Youth Activities” program and authorizing**  
10 **appropriations in the new fund.**

13 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 0571, series of 1998, stipulated that per the 1998 Conditional  
14 Termination of User Agreement between the City and County of Denver and PDB Sports, LTD.,  
15 d/b/a Denver Broncos Football Club associated, the City and County of Denver is entitled to a  
16 “Sharing Amount...equal to 2% of the net profit” associated with the sale of the Broncos Franchise;  
17 and

18 **WHEREAS**, per said agreement, the Sharing Amount must be used for “youth activity  
19 programs”; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Finance (DOF) requires the creation of a new Fund under the  
21 General Government Special Revenue Fund Series, Accounting No. 11000, for revenue and  
22 expenditures related to the Youth Activities Program;

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
25 **DENVER:**

27 **Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund  
28 Series, Accounting No. 11000, the “Youth Activities Program” Fund, Accounting No. 11887, for the  
29 purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.

30 **Section 2.** Monies received from revenue, or other sources of income for Accounting No. 11887  
31 shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 11000,  
32 which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and  
33 County of Denver.

34 **Section 3.** Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Youth Activities Program”  
35 Fund, Accounting No. 11887, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits listed in Section 2 of

1 this ordinance, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Office of Children's Affairs, under  
2 the direction of the Youth Activities Program Commission (or future named entity). Allowable  
3 expenses include program costs for Youth Activities Programs, including personnel, services and  
4 supplies, and capital equipment. This Fund is revenue-based and non-lapsing.

5 **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized  
6 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be  
7 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
