Denver Parks and Recreation has negotiated an agreement with the non-profit Street Kidz to administer programs for youth at the transitional center at Globeville.

Denver Parks and Recreation will partner with Street Kidz to provide programming for youth in the Globeville neighborhood. Street Kids will provide sports and youth mentoring programs.

The benefit to the City is that Globeville Recreation center was identified in 2010 as a transition center and the City is looking to partner with non-profits to continue to provide services to the community.
