A BILL

For an ordinance amending the annual salaries of certain appointed charter officers.

WHEREAS, Colorado Constitution Art. XX, Sec. 2 requires that the compensation of the officers of the City and County of Denver be expressed as a stated salary fixed by ordinance within limits fixed by the Charter; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with § 9.2.3 of the Charter the Career Service Board has determined a pay range for each appointed charter officer listed in § 9.2.1 (B) of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the annual salaries set forth herein do not exceed the maximum salaries set forth in the pay ranges determined by the Career Service Board, as required by § 9.2.3 of the Charter.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That Chapter 18, Article III, Division 2, Section 18-91 of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the language underlined and deleting the language stricken to read as follows:

Section 18-91. Salaries.

The career service board having determined limits of the salaries of appointed charter officers in accordance with the limitations of section 9.2.3 of the Charter, the council hereby fixes the annual salaries as follows:
