This is one of several new contracts for City-wide (open to use by any agency) management and disposal of hazardous and chemical wastes and environmental abatement projects. These services include emergency response to clean-up spills, including from highway traffic accidents. The majority of services anticipated will be to support safe and compliant stewardship, transportation and disposal of hazardous and chemical wastes generated by City operations, but may include large-scale environmental abatement projects, including excavation of contaminated soil. This new contract is needed for continuation of services lost with expired contracts.
