- Executive Employees minimum 50 employees per unit & 5 units until 2030



## What Must be in Ordinance?

- Arbitration of <u>bargaining unit</u> disputes;
- Elections for <u>bargaining agents</u>;
- Negotiations;
- Arbitrators & mediators;
- Court procedure for no-strike determination & back-to-work complaint;
- Final offer and arbitration deadlines for non-striking employees





#### **Bargaining Unit Disputes**

- How and when do employees, corporate authorities, and other unions get <u>notice</u> of a proposed bargaining unit?
- How, when, and with whom are objections filed?
- Is there a <u>pre-arbitration resolution</u>?
- What is the <u>timeline</u> for a challenge?

#### **Selection of Agent**

- How and when does the unit get notice of an election?
- How does voting occur?
- Can employees decide they want <u>no</u> representation?
- When does the election have to occur?
- Can ballots or election results be <u>challenged</u>?
- <u>Electioneering</u> rules?
- · When are results certified?

#### **Procedures for Negotiation**

- How and when do negotiations <u>start</u>?
- How will negotiations be staggered?
- Is there a procedure for <u>final</u> offers?
