11	WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 12-61 of the Denver Revised Municipal			
12	Code ("DRMC"), and by Ordinance No. 302, Series of 2019, there has been approved a			
13	Comprehensive Plan for the City and County of Denver ("Comprehensive Plan 2040"); and			
14	WHEREAS, said Section 12-61 of the DRMC provides for the amendment of the City's			
15	comprehensive plan; and			
16	WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 12-61 DRMC, and by Ordinance No. 58,			
17	Series of 1994, the City accepted the East Montclair/East Colfax Neighborhood Plan as an			
18	amendment to the City's comprehensive plan; and			
19	WHEREAS, the City wishes to repeal and replace the East Montclair/East Colfax			
20	Neighborhood Plan with an updated comprehensive plan supplement entitled, East Area Plan for			
21	the orderly growth and harmonious development of the City and County of Denver; and			
22	WHEREAS, members of the City Council, duly authorized by the president of council have			
23	monitored the process whereby the East Area Plan has been formulated; and			
24	WHEREAS, the East Area Plan has been approved by the Denver Planning Board; and			
25	WHEREAS, the Manager of Community Planning and Development has transmitted the East			
26	Area Plan to the Mayor and Council for acceptance as a supplement to Comprehensive Plan 2040;

28	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF

30	Section 1. That the proposed East Area Plan, consisting of a document of the same name			
31	filed with the City Clerk, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, on October 23, 2020, as			
32	City Clerk Filing No. 20200094 20200094A, is hereby adopted and accepted as a supplement to			
33	Comprehensive Plan 2040, pursuant to Section 12-61(d) of the DRMC.

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Neighborhood Plan in its entirety.

Section 2. That the East Area Plan replaces and supersedes the East Montclair/East Colfax

Section 3. That this adoption and acceptance of the East Area Plan, and of any amendment thereto, in conjunction with Comprehensive Plan 2040, is intended to establish the official guide for officials of the City and County of Denver and private citizens when making decisions affecting the future of land use and transportation in and for the City and County of Denver, as defined in said plan; provided however, that such approval shall not preempt the decision making powers vested by law or administrative directive in the Mayor, the Council or any other official of the City and County of Denver with respect to, but not limited to: a zoning map amendment, a zoning language amendment, a dedication or vacation of a street, alley or other public way, a designation of a park, the issuance of a revocable permit, a conveyance or acquisition of real property by the City and County of Denver, or an appropriation for or construction of a capital improvement; and provided, further that it is expressly understood that judgment must be exercised in the application of the East Area Plan in the decision making processes of the Mayor, Council and other officials of the City and County of Denver.
