6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

This ordinance establishes a capital grant fund number (38402) and appropriates \$2,266,000 to be received from the Denver Rescue Mission (DRM) upon completion of the Lawrence Street Community Center. The Lawrence Street Community Center is a Downtown TIF project that supports goals outlined in the Shelter System of Denver’s Ten-Year Plan to End Homelessness administered by Denver’s Road Home. The City has executed a capital grant agreement with DRM which states that upon the opening of the Lawrence Street Community Center, the City will receive reimbursement in the amount of \$2,266,000. This funding will continue to support City homelessness goals and will be utilized for the acquisition of the property located at 405 S. Platte for the development of the new Solutions Center.

This ordinance will set up a capital grant fund and appropriate the budget for this grant as follows:
