Funding will help to support 2,500 youth per year across the Barnum, Sunnyside, and Athmar neighborhoods through the Jovial Concepts signature gardening, nutrition, cooking, and enrollment activities. These activities meet all three of HFDK priority areas including nutritious food access and security; enrollment in federal nutrition assistance programs; and food education. On average, more than 90% of youth served identify as BIPOC and are from low-income or poverty level families.
